It also has a very strong support system for students. There are lots of reasons to choose XXXX for my study as it is also located in the city of my choice i.e. Melbourne.

The main reason for choosing the Melbourne is Lifestyle, multicultural community, climate, education system; culture and environment are the basic attractions of Melbourne. As for me, the prime attraction is the wealth of opportunities for international students like me. The stunning coastline, diverse nightlife and food culture are some good reasons for Melbourne. Melbourne is safe for international students. The contribution of the skilled workforce is inevitable to support the economic growth, especially the role of Technology are countless. In the context of globalization, the demands for the Technologists are

growing. However, the number of Technologists is not sufficient to cope with the requirements. After the completion, I want to contribute the varied range of Technology sector. In addition, Recently Nepal has been able to provide proper education in the field of information technology but we are still lacking well managed system and practical fields. Only 5 accredited universities are available here for which competition is very tough to get admissions. Also we have to pass through various entrance exams which are the derivatives of American College Testing(ACT), Graduate Record Examination(GRE), Graduate Management Admissions Test(GMAT), Scholastic Aptitude Test(SAT). These take a lot of time to do. Even we passed and got admissions in college, education is not globally recognized. Also education in Nepal is only theoretically based due to which we cannot gain proper knowledge regarding in the practical fields. Modern technologies and facilities are not available in college, all what we learn is in same traditional method which is not recognized in any other countries except Nepal. Exams in colleges are not properly timed in Nepal due to which students need to face problem every time. Most of the universities in Nepal are yearly based instead on semester basis due to which students feel difficult to attend exams. Also we need to struggle in Nepal with the degree what we gained in Nepal. So I have chosen to study in Australia to gain proper education so that I can help my nation to move forward.

After successful completion of Bachelor in Information and Communications Technology, I will apply for post study work (PSW) which will be eligible for two years. Its visa subclass is 485. After the successful completion of PSW I will have both international work experience and international degree which will add an advantage in my career prospects. Candidates with both degree and work experience of an international level are preferred as more qualified and competent in my country which helps me to get good job in my country after I return back to my country. Once I have international degree and

students studying in Australia on student visa are able to work part time up to 40 hours per fortnight while the program is in session.


